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SCC Classes

- FHS students can take SCC classes through a program called Career & College Promise (CCP). It is a unique program that allows qualified high school students to take a variety of college-credit courses at little cost to them or their families.
- Students may begin a pathway toward an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree with general education classes, OR...
- Students may take classes in a career and technical field that aligns with the high school career clusters.

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SCC Classes

- Classes are offered:
 - on the SCC main campus in Dobson
 - at a satellite campus called the Yadkin Center
 - online (in an on-site computer lab at FHS)



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SCC Classes

- Requirements to be CCP eligible:
 - must be a junior or senior
 - have an unweighted GPA of 2.8
 - OR demonstrate college readiness on an assessment or placement test for English, Reading, and Math
 - complete any prerequisite high school courses (Example: Carpentry 1 and Carpentry 2 in order to take Construction Technology)

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Accommodations

- If a student currently has an IEP or 504 plan, students must initiate the process for receiving accommodations at the college.
- Students complete an intake form through their MyKnightLife account. Then the documentation must be submitted to the Office of Disability Services.

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Yadkin Guarantee

- Must graduate from a Yadkin County HS with an unweighted GPA above a 2.3
- Must maintain a 2.0 GPA
- Must submit the FAFSA
- Covers 100% of tuition for classes at the Yadkin Center
- Covers 100% of tuition for two additional classes
- Covers 50% of tuition on classes in Dobson
- Provides \$750 book stipend



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AP Classes

- Desired by more competitive universities
- Syllabus must be approved by the College Board
- AP exams are administered in early May
- Colleges award credit for proficient scores
- No cost for students in YCS
- 1st Semester is Honors Credit (0.5 credit added to GPA)
- 2nd Semester is AP Credit (1 credit added to GPA)

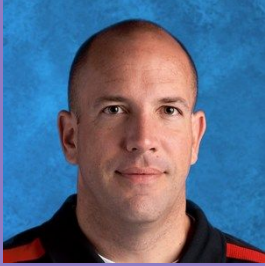

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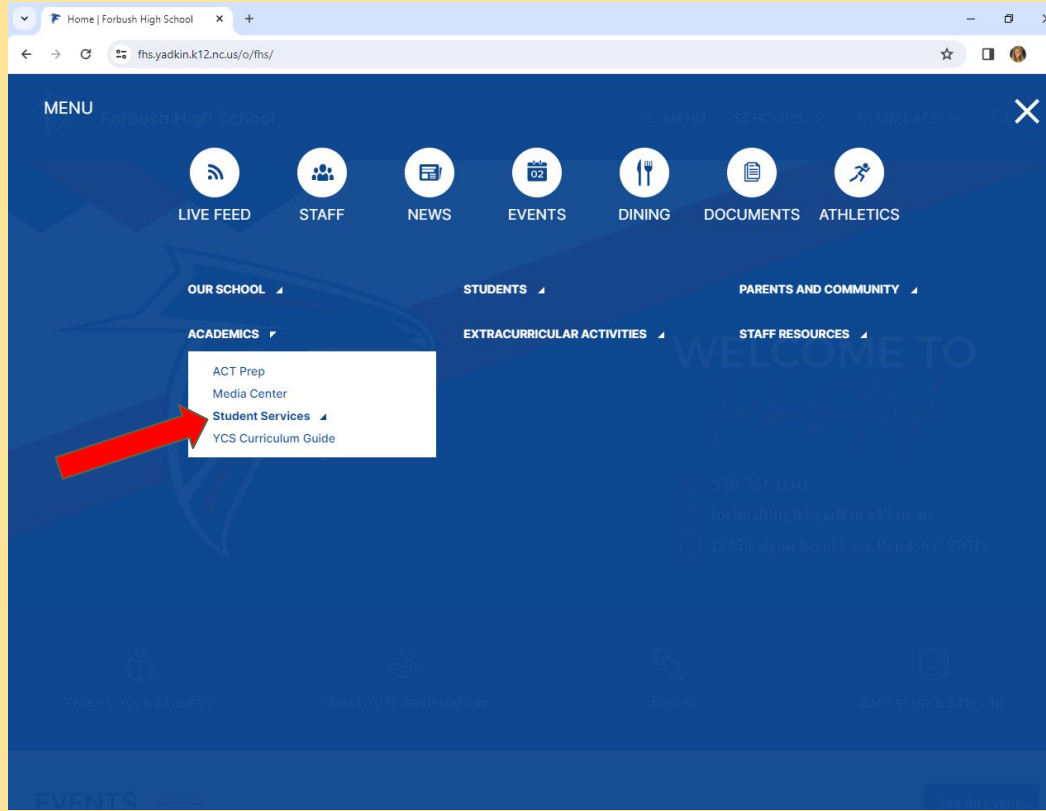

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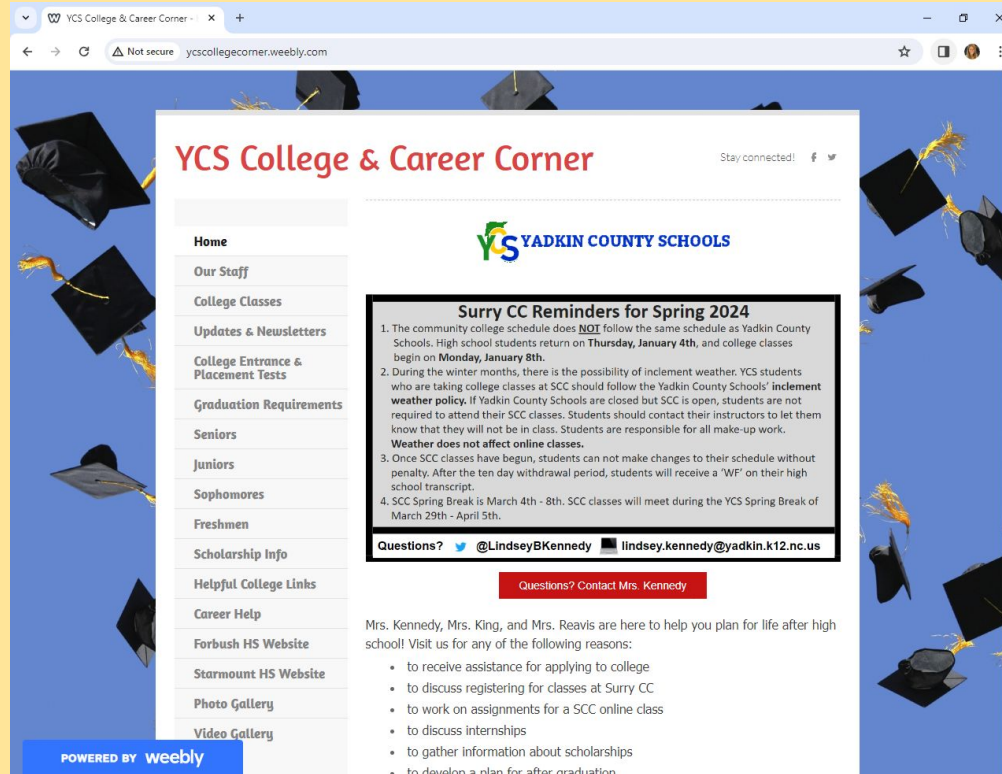
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
